

Dade Elementary School is now accepting applications for a Health/Physical Education teacher for the FY-23 Fiscal School Year.

Minimum Requirements:

Applicants must be familiar with Georgia Performance Standards, hold a valid Georgia teaching certificate or eligible; Highly qualified to teach the subject and/or class assigned as defined by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission.

Applicants must be able to plan, organize, and deliver engaging lessons aligned with the physical education performance standards. This includes organizing skill development and collaborative activities for students ranging from the Pre-Kindergarten through 5th grade.

In addition, exhibiting positive behavior is an essential skill for character development.

Therefore, applicants that have prior experiences serving in some leadership capacity such as lead teacher, grade-level leader, club sponsor, or any other leadership role will be given strong consideration.

A copy of your current teaching certificate and a minimum of three references should be included with the Teach Georgia application.

Furthermore, official college transcripts(s) and Praxis/GACE score reports should be readily available upon further request.
