

FY20-21 Policies for Students Riding the Bus:

- Masks or face shields are mandatory for any student or monitor riding on the bus the entire time they are on the bus. There will be no exceptions.
- Every student will be given an assigned seat. They will be required to sit in this seat each time they ride the bus for the entire trip, one child per seat when possible.
- Students living in the same house should be seated together if at all possible.
- Students will be expected to maintain social distancing (6') when loading and unloading from the bus.
- As feasible, students will be distanced by placing one student per seat or an empty seat between riders not of the same household
- Parents/Guardians must agree to the above policies for their child(ren) to ride the bus; this includes mandatory mask-wearing, and assigned seating.
- Students will not be permitted to ride the bus if they do not cooperate with these rules.

FY20-21 Policies for Bus Drivers:

- Masks or face shields are mandatory the entire time you are on the bus. There will be no exceptions. Gloves are also recommended.
- Drivers are required to ***disinfect*** buses between routes using the following protocol:
 1. Wiping down with disinfectant wipes frequently touched areas:

Driver Compartment - All knobs, levers, switches, seat belt ends, microphones/radio, overhead console switches/buttons.

2. Fogging the entire bus using the disinfecting fogging machine ensuring the entire interior of the bus has been fogged including windows and ledges.
- A list of bus riders will be compiled by each driver and tracked daily to assist in contact tracing, in the event a bus rider or driver tests positive for COVID-19. The bus should not leave out on a route without this list.
 - Upon any release of bodily fluids there must be documentation as to the student, date/time, and method of disinfection including a listing of the disinfectant used.
