Each year Dade County Schools provides Special Education referral information to multiple locations in Dade County. Child Find is a process that public school systems use to identify, locate and evaluate all children, birth through twenty-one, who have (or may have) a disability that results in a need for special education and related services.

Anyone can make a referral. If you suspect a child (birth through age twenty-one) may have a disability, discuss your concerns with the parent/guardian. Inform the parent/guardian that you are making a referral.
